



PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOLUNTEERS

1. EQUIPMENT

We provide paint, threads and the painting kart.

Our painter instructor will show each volunteer group how to paint. It is super easy but needs to be done right so our fields look professional!

2. REQUIRED PAINTING PROCEDURE

Note: The thread line must be used so lines are straight and our field looks professional.

- (1) Two people hold the thread between two points and the third person paints.
- (2) Then move the thread to the next parallel line or segment. Do all vertical lines first, then the horizontal lines. It is faster.
- (3) Finish with the arches/curves (if present for your field).
- (4) Once done, one of the group's members will take all equipment home (the kart handle can be folded -- see pic, and fits in any car's trunk) and bring it to the next set of volunteers the following week.



3. PAINTING CANS TIP

Before using, the cans must be shaken thoroughly until you hear clinking noises (there is a plastic piece inside), and then continue to shake for 30 seconds. The paint is water based but you may want to use a mask.
